PHIL 175 MODERN PHILOSOPHY

This course addresses 16th through 18th century philosophy with emphasis on the broad epistemological and metaphysical developments of empiricism and rationalism in philosophical thought from Descartes to Kant. Special topics include the foundation of knowledge, the nature of the human mind, free will, and the foundation of morality. *Grade Option (Letter Grade or Pass/No Pass). Degree Credit.*
